

Meeting Minutes for November 4, 2013

The minutes from the last meeting were approved

Brad shared the highlights from the October monthly report:

- Stroller Fitness class got some great publicity in the News Messenger
- Attendance was 8786 people this past month in the Recreation Center
- Ghouls Gathering had 100 people in attendance
- Youth football has come to an end this year and basketball placement practices are starting next week
- New adjustable basketball goals for this year that won't tip over and are much more safe for the children
- Church volleyball has 12 teams this year and they will play every Tuesday until Christmas then will have a double elimination tournament
- Had 39 participants for the free basketball clinic that we did in conjunction with RU Men's basketball
 - Lots of positive feedback
- Health and Wellness Fair had close to 200 people
- Special Populations had a Halloween Dance with 235 participants
- Five different organizations requesting tournament dates for our Outdoor Parks and Facilities
- Huckleberry trail is making big headways in getting paved and is looking really nice
 - Opens Blacksburg up to us here in Christiansburg
- Tommy Barber has come to Brad wanting to bring Buddy Camp to Christiansburg
 - Amazing opportunity teaming high school age children with younger (pre-school/Kindergarten) developmentally delayed children for one week during the camp
 - It is a half day camp with each day having classes with the children and then a field trip (Chuck E Cheese, Mill Mountain Zoo, etc.)
 - This is a way for us to reach out to children outside of sports
 - Brad showed video about the camp
 - Looking at dates for next summer to start this camp here in Christiansburg
- Brad Mecom brought in the rough draft of the survey for the Master Plan
 - Get an understanding of people within the town's recreation use

- Possibly using 'Survey Monkey' to have the survey online, putting a paper survey in the utility bills, in high traffic areas around the town, and in our next brochure
- New River Valley Community Services have contacted us asking us to use our facility one to two times a week. They would like us to waive all fees for their staff who are not town residents anytime they would like to come with the clients.
 - This would be 6-12 individuals along with their staff members
 - In the past this has not worked out because the staff member would not always stay with the client and work with them only while in the recreation center
 - The board recommended at this time to not waive the fees
- Mike Barbers last meeting will be in December and after that Cord Hall will be the liaison for the Town Council
