

**Christiansburg Aquatic Center
Advisory Board
August 5, 2015**

The meeting was called to order by Jeremy Williams.

Jeremy motioned to accept the minutes from last meeting. Shirley seconded the motion.

I. Old Business

- a. Town Employee Free Membership and Classes
 - i. 58 town employees/first responders have signed up for a membership. Two have signed up for family memberships and 10 have signed up for a couple's membership.
 - ii. Three employees have signed up for one fitness class.
- b. CAC 5 Year Anniversary Celebration June 26 & 27
 - i. Buy 6 months, get 6 free total bought: 235
 - ii. Buy 12 visits, get 12 free total bought: 121
- c. Fin's Summer Camp
 - i. The camp is on its last week, "Boat Design"
 - ii. Total of 9 weeks with 514 children.
 - iii. Camps will be held again during the holiday season when schools are closed.
 - iv. Next year, look into offering discounts to children to come back after camp.

II. New Business

- a. Maintenance Week Shutdown: August 17-28. New alligator slide will be installed during this time. Public has been asked to name the new alligator(in facility and on Facebook). The person with the winning name will receive a free 12 visit pass to the aquatic center.
 - i. Grit coating will be placed on pool deck tile.
- b. Aquatic Center Annual Report (see following pages.)
- c. No vaping signs have been placed around the facility.
- d. The next brochure is in the works and will be available by the end of August.
 - i. Roanoke Times distribution in September.
- e. Radford University Memberships
 - i. Faculty, Staff, Students and Retirees are free, their spouse receive 20% off.
 - ii. The board suggested the CAC approach President Sands at Virginia Tech about a similar deal.
- f. Request for one stop: nails, hair and massage.
 - i. "Spa Day" fair or women's expo, "pampered day". Sell tickets, limited seating.

- ii. Steve suggested that we contact local businesses and see if they would be interested in coming to the CAC
- iii. Terry will look into partnering with the Chamber.
- g. Request for special membership prices also go for programs.
- h. Request for Valet Parking during busy times.
 - i. The CAC staff can use the CAC car to pick up in the lower lots.
 - ii. Call ahead, sign a waiver. 12p-3p. Monday-Friday.
 - iii. Pick up service; sell how it goes during the fall. Make the pick up a specific spot.
 - iv. Terry will take the request to Barry Helms.
- i. Request for a dry pass membership
 - i. Dry pass is \$2, the CAC has 12 dry passes for \$20
 - ii. CAC staff will work on prices
 - iii. Cardio Pass for cardio room use only
- j. Request for reduced fees for veterans/active duty
 - i. The board voted to give 20% off all advertised rates.
 - ii. The board voted to give \$3 daily admission.
- k. VA payments
 - i. The CAC has been asked to accept payment from the VA for veterans' therapy. The CAC does not have a licensed therapist on staff.
