Jeremy Williams called the meeting to order.

Steve motioned to approve the minutes from last meeting with Shirley seconding.

1. Terry's Report
  - a. NYE Event was a huge success with 175 participants
    - i. Ball drop from the 10 meter tower
    - ii. "Champagne" toast
    - iii. Water bouncer, kayaks, floats, door prizes, "photo booth"
  - b. Spring Events
    - i. Souper Splash will be held in May- partnered with NRVCS and Montgomery County Prevention Partners
    - ii. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Community Yard Sale is scheduled for May 13 with a rain date of May 20
    - iii. The CAC is now entering the swim meet season with five coming up in February
  - c. Councilman Showalter's suggestions for free or reduced admittance for athletes and/or families of the Christiansburg High School swim/dive team during the season
    - i. The board voted to allow the swimmers/divers and their family free admittance to the CAC. October-February.
  - d. The lobby now has a new signage software program through Reach Media
2. New Business
  - a. Mr. Huppert discussed his plans for a Relay for Life at the CAC
    - i. Participants would walk/swim as many laps as they feel comfortable- goal of 10 miles
    - ii. Middle of March in the leisure pool
    - iii. Free admission to swim/walk- \$10 fee would go to Relay for Life
    - iv. The board suggested that the CAC co-host with Relay for Life
    - v. The board motioned to hold the event. Terry and staff will work on the scheduling.
  - b. Mr. Huppert discussed digital signage throughout the town.
    - i. The town will have one digital sign outside of town hall
  - c. Shirley is working with students from Ignite to time swim meets
