A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CHRISTIANSBURG TOWN COUNCIL, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, CHRISTIANSBURG, VA. WAS HELD AT CHRISTIANSBURG TOWN HALL, 100 EAST MAIN STREET, CHRISTIANSBURG, VIRGINIA, ON JULY 10, 2018 AT 7:00 P.M.

VIII. DISCUSSION BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL

- A. Council action on:
 1. Conditional Use Permit request by Marie E. March, agent for Big Bear Properties LLC/Fatback Soul Shack LLC for a loudspeaker/sound amplification/outdoor sound system to be used in excess of the Town of Christiansburg's Noise Ordinance at 2440 Roanoke Street (Tax Map Nos. 500 – A – 8A; 500 – A – 8; and 500 – A – 9B, 9C, 9D) in the B-3 General Business zoning district. The Public Hearing was held June 26, 2018. On a vote of 6 ayes, 1 nay, the Planning Commission recommended Town Council approve the CUP with three conditions as outlined by Town Manager Wingfield. Councilman Stipes made a motion to accept the Planning Commission recommendation to issue the CUP with three conditions, seconded by Councilman Showalter. Council voted on the motion as follows: Bishop – Aye; Collins – Aye; Huppert – Aye; Sachs – Aye; Showalter – Aye; Stipes – Aye.
 2. Conditional Use Permit request by Marie E. March, agent for Big Bear Properties LLC/Due South BBQ LLC for a loudspeaker/sound amplification/outdoor sound system to be used in excess of the Town of Christiansburg's Noise Ordinance at 1465 and 1495 Roanoke Street (Tax Map No. 529 – 8 – 27) in the B-3 General Business zoning district. The Public Hearing was held June 26, 2018. On a vote of 7 ayes, 0 nay, the Planning Commission recommended Town Council approve the CUP with two conditions as outlined by Town Manager Wingfield. Councilwoman Sachs made a motion to accept the Planning Commission recommendation to issue the CUP with two conditions, seconded by Councilman Collins. Council voted on the motion as follows: Bishop – Aye; Collins – Aye; Huppert – Aye; Sachs – Aye; Showalter – Aye; Stipes – Aye.
- B. Consideration of funding a \$7,000 field inventory of housing conditions as an optional add-on to the New River Valley Regional Commission's Regional and Local Housing Study that is being conducted in partnership with the Virginia Housing Development Authority.

Town Manager Wingfield reported on the add-on study that would provide the Town with a heat map based on a housing rating scale of 1-5 of recorded housing condition visible from public streets. The results would be public and could be used as supporting documentation in obtaining grants for housing rehab in low- to moderate-income areas. The annual CDBG funding, which the town typically uses for sidewalk maintenance/extension, could be used for housing rehabilitation though this is currently limited to the area bounded by Roanoke Street, E. Main Street and Depot Street, N.E. The study would not expand the areas in which CDBG funding could be used. Councilman Stipes noted that he appreciated the information provided but doesn't see a direct benefit to the town in approving the study since the town historically has not obtained housing rehab grants. Councilman Showalter commented that senior housing would be identified in the study, but that the Town had already participated in a study identifying that

demographic through the NRV Regional Commission, with Councilwoman Sachs noting that the Town already had enough information to conclude housing conditions without the add-on study. The consensus of Council was to not approve funding of a field inventory of housing conditions as an optional add-on to the New River Valley Regional Commission's Regional and Local Housing Study.

C. Reappointment of Wayne Nelson to the New River Valley Regional Water Authority for a four-year term beginning July 1, 2018. Councilman Showalter made a motion to reappoint Wayne Nelson to serve another 4-year term on the New River Valley Regional Water Authority, effective July 1, 2018, seconded by Councilman Collins. Council voted on the motion as follows: Bishop – Aye; Collins – Aye; Huppert – Aye; Sachs – Aye; Showalter – Aye; Stipes – Aye. Council thanked Mr. Nelson for his service in this capacity.

He then reported that sixty-three students from CHS were participating in the ACCE program, and that many of the students would be assisting with the event as part of their community service requirements.

Mayor Barber said he received many positive comments from the community on the new location of the fireworks display.
