

November 6 Meeting Minutes

- Assistant Directors Report- Attendance for the month of October was 5537. Our Adult Church Volleyball has 24 teams participating this season.

- Athletic Special Events- In the month of October we hosted two travel tournaments that had over 65 teams participating. The softball tournament had 50 teams. - Senior & Special Populations- we have community choir that meets on Mondays with 26 participants. The shred a thon had 282 cars that came through. We held an Aging in Your Community Workshop, it had 28 participants. We had our IDA Halloween Dance, at the end of the month that had 150 participants.
- Youth Athletics- We have finished up our Youth Football Season and we have started Mite & Pee Wee basketball. We hosted the NRV Superbowl this year, we had two teams that played in that. Our Mite team lost, and our Senior team won. Our youth volleyball leagues took off again this fall, with 105 players.
- Specials Events / Farmers Market- Our last market was October 26 with 358 people in attendance for it. We held Rocking Main on Oct. 14 we still had a good attendance, but weather did play a role in it. We had our Getting Scary on the Huckleberry and Touch a Truck the Saturday before Halloween. We had 102 runners and a very well attended touch a truck. The next event will be Christmas on Main & Winter Wonderland.
