- A. Councilwoman Hockett made a motion for a request for a Closed Meeting under Code of Virginia § 2.2-3711(A)(3), for the discussion or consideration of the acquisition of real property for a public purpose, or of the disposition of publicly held real property, where discussion in an open meeting would adversely affect the bargaining position or negotiating strategy of the public body. The Closed Meeting is being held for discussion of potential sale of located at the intersection of Peppers Ferry Road, NW and Booker T. Washington Parkway, N.W. (an approximately 5-acre northeastern portion of Tax Parcel 435 – ((A)) – 3A, Parcel ID 270079). The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Hicks. 
D. Council action on the matters
