

February 5 Meeting Minutes

- Ms. Fenton called meeting to order.

- Ms. Smart made the motion to accept the minutes from December, and Mr. Boyd second. November minutes were approved.
- No citizen comments.
- Directors Report- we have installed our new Civic Rec software in November. We have 2041 memberships and had attendance of 6035.
- Youth Sports- Basketball is in full force now, with great numbers. We registration is going on now for Baseball & Softball leagues. We did find out that we are staying with Cal Ripken within the New River Valley. We have been asked to do the 10u state tournament this year, July 3-6. Registration is going on for Volleyball, we have two leagues for this sport due to high participation.
- Adult Sports- We are currently taking registration for Volleyball & Softball. We have combined our basketball leagues to make one this winter.
- Athletic Special Events- January is a big month for us, we hosted the Rockstar Gymnastic Event that was four days with 1200-1500 gymnast. We have confirmed with the Virginia Tech Women's Basketball team that we will do a clinic with them this summer. We are working on dates with the Men's team for this summer. Travel baseball/softball dates have been confirmed and sent out. We are finalizing the guns and hoses game that benefits Special Olympics. We are starting to schedule tournaments at Christiansburg Huckleberry Park.
- Farmers Market- Our manager received a \$200 scholarship to attend the VA Farmers Market Association Market Manager Certification Class. We have also confirmed a \$1,000 donation from the Community Housing Partners for the Snap match program.
- Special Events- We are getting to go full force with our events. We have our Easter Events, adult easter egg hunt with glow in the dark eggs. Then we will have our kids egg hunt at Kiwanis Park. April 20th we will have our Spring Kickoff Event at the Recreation Center. Once we finish Spring Kickoff, we are going to host after prom for Christiansburg High School, 11p.m. to 2a.m. We will be back into full force with our Rockin Main Series starting in May.
- Outdoor Facilities- We have been dealing with vandalism at our outdoor facilities. We had our monthly check on the call towers, and everything is working properly. We also placed net around the toro area at the new park to keep the soccer balls from going outside of it.
- Community Programs- This is a busy time of the year for our pre-school, adult, and special interest classes. We have two new classes, that are getting a lot of attention, Barre, and Adult Tap Class. We did have 12 employees recertified in CPR Training.
- Senior & Special Population- We held an American Red Cross Blood Drive that had 14 participants. We have also gone on a couple different trips with the seniors.
- We did run into some items at the new park. When the weather got very cold the heat went out at the bathrooms, Director Epperley sent an email. We are going back and forth the contractor about these items and some others.
- Student Report- Construction has started at the High School.
- Mr. Nelson and Mr. Warren is presenting on the installing solar at the Recreation Center & Aquatic Center. There is no upfront cost to the town or maintenance charges. Planning to present this to town council on Feb. 13. We will have to run this for two consecutive weeks for competing proposals.
