

March 4 Meeting Minutes

- Directors Report- We have actively increased our memberships since starting Civic Rec Software Program.
- Youth Sports- Youth Basketball has finished up and was an overall great season. Baseball/Softball registration is taking place now. Youth Volleyball skyrocketed for us this spring, with 142 participants.
- Adult Sports- We have 12 teams in our Basketball League. We are taking registration for our Volleyball Leagues. We did host a volleyball tournament with 20 teams participating.
- We hosted two AAU Basketball Tournaments this month, with a total of 99 teams participating. We are working on our Summer Clinics for the children, working with Virginia Tech and Christiansburg High School. At the end of June we will host Jill's Buddy Camp. We have set the date for the Fishing Rodeo Oct. 5. We are currently organizing the Senior Games as we are the host for the events this year.
- Senior Programs - We had 20 participants for our Valentines Day bingo. We have worked with IDA for the sweetheart dance that 119 participants.
- Adopt A Spot- We have six groups working with this, and two new ones that will be starting soon.
- Community Programs- Karate has done very well with our youth programs. Our adult programs as usual are doing great, we have new program Adult Tap Dancing with 12 participants. Our dog obedience classes are doing well, with averaging nine.
- Farmers Markets- The market is schedule to open May 16th. Our market manager has been working hard in the off season to vamp the market up. We currently have 12 applications for the community garden. Upcoming easter events, we are doing an Adult Easter Egg Hunt March 22. Our Children's Easter Egg Hunt will take place March 30. We are also doing our Spring Kickoff Festival April 20 in our Parking Lot. We will also be hosting After Prom after kickoff festival. Rockin' Main Street, we do have all our acts setup for that.
- Outdoor Facilities – Our staff has been very busy to get ready for the spring. We are very close to putting the restrooms in at Downtown Park. Public Works is set to do the preliminary work. We have started practices with the Middle School at Harkrader & Kiwanis.
