

## October 7 Meeting Minutes

- Ms. Fenton called meeting to order.

- Assistant Directors Report- September our attendance was 5317 and we had a total of 4026 active memberships.
- Athletic Special Events- We have hosted three baseball/softball tournaments this past month. Last weekend we had the Tony L. Huddleston Fishing Rodeo, we had over 100 children in attendance.
- Special Events & Farmers Market- This is the first time we have partner with DCI, the event went awesome. Councilman Wilson asked if we planned to do this with them again, we hope to do this as an annual event with DCI, Councilman Wilson is for it. He also asked if there was any other potential of doing any other types of events with DCI. Our next event is the Getting Scary on the Huckleberry/Truck or Treat at the end of October. We helped with the Wilderness Trail festival this past month. This past month farmers market averaged about 563 people in attendance, even with one canceled market and rain market.
- Youth Athletics- Fall is our busy time for sports, we have football, cheerleading, fall baseball/softball, & volleyball.
- Senior Programs- Our Senior Motions & Move Groove are still exceling daily. We did host the AARP/VCOM/CDPR Health and Wellness Fair, we had over 400 participants come in the Recreation Center for that. We did our host the 17<sup>th</sup> annual Walk a Thon for Supplies for Senior, we 25 participants.
- Community Programs- Energy Outlet has six participants in it and Ballet has seven participants. Our adult exercise classes are still going strong. Stargazing program is still very popular at the hilltop at the Huckleberry Park. We also had the Town Health Fair for employees.
- Outdoor Facilities- We hosted our first Softball Tournament at the Huckleberry Park.
- Adult Athletics- We have 23 teams in our Church League Volleyball, 12 in the Coed Volleyball League, eight in the Women's League. We had nine teams in our Men's Fall Softball League.
- Student Report- They had their homecoming dance. Some of the girl's cross-country team wants to still volunteer for the 5k Getting Scary on the Huckleberry
