

April 7 Meeting Minutes

- Ms. Fenton called meeting to order.

- Ms. Smart made the motion to accept the minutes from March and Mr. Wilson seconds. March minutes were approved.
- Citizen Comments – N/A
- Assistant Directors Report- Total memberships for the month of March is 3666 and attendance was 4418.
- Youth Athletics- Youth Basketball season is over. We are currently still in Volleyball with 27 participants in Junior and 77 participants in Senior. We are wrapping up with Baseball Softball registration. We have 66 participants in Tball, 66- Boys Coach Pitch, 56- 10u Baseball, 25- 12u Baseball, 25- Girls Coach Pitch, and 12-10u Softball. We held a two-day camp for each age division.
- Community Programs – Our preschool classes are at their maximum number of participants. Youth Karate has five participants. Adult Abs / Arms has 11 participants. Our dog obedience class are still going very well.
- Senior Programs – Our senior exercise classes are going very strong. We had a St Patrick's Day Bingo with 14 participants.
- Special Events/Farmers Market- We held our first event of the year, Spring Kick Festival – it was a beautiful day for it. We are hosting our Easter Events this upcoming weekend at Christiansburg Huckleberry Park and Kiwanis Park. We have sent out applications for the Farmers Market vendors, we have 12 confirmed. Our community garden has taken off, with 25 confirmed plots.
- Adult Athletics- We have finished Church League Basketball and are close to finishing Open Slow Break. We are taking registrations for Volleyball.
- Outdoor Facility Maintenance- We did have a pole taken out during the ice storm at Christiansburg Huckleberry Park and are awaiting a replacement.
- Indoor Facility Maintenance- The renovations for the women's bathroom are still ongoing, our staff did build some dividers to be able to use them during some events. We retiled the breezeway at the front entrance.
- Master Scheduler- We hosted one AAU tournament with 40 teams. We started Outdoor Tournaments at the fields this past weekend. We also held two big events the Recreation Center, NRVHB Home Show & Virginia State Gymnastics Meet.
- Recreation Center- We have installed a new stair master in the cardio room. We had 21 indoor rentals the month of March.
- Old Business- Councilman Wilson asked what the status was on the splash pad, the company is sending someone to come work on the splash pad.
- Student Report- We are getting ready for Prom at Christiansburg High School. Construction is coming along and getting closer to be finished.
- New business- Ms. Meadows was approached by some parents about children not being watched while here at the Recreation Center during the games. The children are in the courts and tracks instead of sitting in the bleachers. Mr. Neel mentions that maybe an email should be sent out to coaches about siblings needs to be with parents and in the bleachers.
