- Directors Reports- Adult Athletics, our Volleyball Leagues are into their regular season. We will be starting Softball Leagues in June.
- Youth Athletics- We are finishing up regular season for youth baseball and softball. We will have an all-star team in the 10u division. The past week was a difficult week with the weather. We were having a softball tournament at the Christiansburg Huckleberry Park for the weekend, so we went ahead and set it up early for the teams to be able to finish out their regular season.
- Senior & Special Population Programs- Our Senior Exercise Classes are doing very well. We did tie in our Community Cancer Event into our first Farmers Market. We had the summer picnic for Triad this past month. This is a great event partnering with Sheriff's Office and Police Department.
- Community Programs- We held Merit Badge Classes once school was out for summer. Those classes did very well. Typically, in the summer our adult exercise classes slow down a little bit. We held a lunch and learn program with Harry Collins. He wrote a couple books about his life and how he has overcome items. A few employees attended the Virginia Tech Employee Health Fair – that had 3000 participants.
- Special Events/Farmers Market- We had our first Rockin Main of the season with a huge crowd. We have another one scheduled for Saturday, June 14. We have started planning for the Fourth of July Festival Downtown. We have had to change our footprint due to the road closure. We have already secured our fireworks for next year due to it being the 250th anniversary of America. We have a couple of sanction events this past month. We have had three weeks of the Farmers Market. The first weeks were at the Recreation Center and the third week was at the Christiansburg Huckleberry Park.
- Outdoor Facilities- We recently have put in decorative fence at the Downtown Park. We have de-winterize everything outside. We have opened the splash park, and everything is going well with that. We have purchased more bleachers for the Christiansburg Huckleberry Park, and it will give each field four sets.
- Indoor Facilities- All fire extinguishers have been inspected in the facility and vehicles. We have installed new fire extinguishers and cabinets at Christiansburg Huckleberry Park & Kiwanis Park. The staff has begun waxing the basketball courts and shuffleboard courts. We held the ACCE Fair gain this year, we ended up with 30 volunteers. We met with the solar project company, and it looks like they will start at the Aquatic Center. They will begin work here around June 25.
- Athletic Special Events- We had two basketball tournaments with 75 teams. We held two baseball tournaments and one softball tournament at Harkrader Sports Complex. We had a lacrosse tournament and softball tournament at the Christiansburg Huckleberry Park. We have secured the Mike Young Basketball Camp the last two weeks of June. We will have the Jills Buddy Camp the last week in June. We also got confirmation the Virginia Tech Women's Basketball Clinic will be here in July. The Tony Huddleston Fishing Rodeo is Saturday, Oct.4.
- Customer Service- Our staff managed the tournaments at the park.
- Dylan Vest, Crew Leader passed the certification for playground safety.
- Student Report- School is out for Summer. They are still wrapping up their spring sports.
