

Christiansburg Aquatic Center
Advisory Board Meeting
February 2, 2011

In Attendance: Steve Simmons, Bert Locklin, Jim Vanhoozier, Jeremy Williams, Terry Caldwell, Michael St. Jean, Cord Hall, Shirley Hallock, Maddie Duke.

The meeting was called to order by Jeremy Williams.

Shirley made motion to approve minutes from the previous meeting, Steve second the motion and minutes were approved.

Terry gave an update on the public comment concerning the weather policy's affect on water aerobics classes. Another group of participants from another morning class came to Terry and it was agreed upon that if Montgomery County Schools are closed but the participants can still make it over to the Aquatic Center during their class time, there will be aerobic DVDs they can watch and participate in during their scheduled class time.

Terry informed the group that the Aquatic Center has purchased a movie license. The license is for 1 year and gives the Aquatic Center permission for the use of many movies.

A general discussion was held about the Senior Olympics that will be held on April 20th. The Aquatic Center will host the swimming portion which will be held in the afternoon. Flyers will be made in-house and sent to local organizations.

A general discussion was held about upcoming meets that will be held at the Aquatic Center.

Terry presented the November and December 2010 revenue reports.

Terry read a complaint from a town resident stating that the single membership rates are not affordable. This issue was discussed further and Mr. Vanhoozier noted that the Aquatic Center has affordable monthly payment plans.

Terry discussed John Huntington's donation. With his consent, this donation will be used to purchase the Christiansburg Aquatic Center's "Blue Fins" shark mascot costume. This mascot will be used at the Aquatic Center's swim meets, special events and as a marketing tool throughout the community.

Town Council will be held at the Aquatic Center on March 15th to recognize the CHS football team. Cord Hall addressed the idea that the football team would be able to use the pool after the council meeting. That is still to be discussed and worked out with the Aquatic Center Staff and Town Council.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
