PUBLIC HEARING

The Town of Christiansburg Virginia as a recipient of block grant funding is required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to prepare and adopt a multiyear Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plans that solicit citizen views on proposed Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program activities contained in these documents. The plan outlines proposed activities for CDBG funding and specific activities for this program year beginning July 1, 2012. The 2012-2013 Annual Action Plan details the continuation of sidewalk and infrastructure projects in Census Block 02-0800-02, commonly referred to as the Park District.
