AQUATICS

The Christiansburg Aquatic Center is home to a 50-meter, Olympic-sized pool, a 1-meter and 3-meter spring board and a 10-meter diving platform. The state-of-the-art facility has a leisure pool with water tumbling buckets, sprinklers, kid slides, a two-story triple-loop waterslide for the older kids, and a 20-meter, four-lane lap pool. Next to the leisure pool is a warm-water therapy pool. Catch some rays on the sundeck outside the leisure pool or eat lunch on one of the many picnic tables.

ABOUT

The Town of Christiansburg is settled within stately views of the Blue Ridge Mountains and the winding path of the New River in Southwest Virginia. The Town serves as a destination for retail, recreation and specialized community events, garnering the tagline; "Christiansburg: The Place to Be".

Originally a concentration of taverns and rest stops along the Great Wilderness Road (now U.S. Route 11), the original 1.1 square mile town was established in 1792 and later incorporated in 1833. Famous residents and visitors include Davy Crockett, Daniel Boone and Booker T. Washington.

Christiansburg is nearly 15 square miles and is the fourth largest town in Virginia with 23,348 residents (2020 census). The Town is located minutes from Virginia Tech, Radford University, two major hospitals and the I-81 corridor. History, heritage and progress are rich within the Christiansburg community, showcasing museums and architecture representing where we have been and where we are going. Accenting our vibrant historical community is a plethora of dining, shopping and leisure activities including a state-of-the-art indoor aquatics facility, and a new regional park that boasts first-class facilities including an all-abilities playground for safe access to recreational amenities.

SHOPPING & DINING

Cambria

Visit Cambria for a peek into this region's past. In early summer, join our community to watch Norfolk & Western's 611 steam locomotive as it makes its way through Christiansburg. You'll also find gift shops, antiques, artisans and a fan-favorite mural painted by local artist, Morgan Short.



Downtown

Our downtown scene is a cultural center and gathering place for the community. Here you'll find thriving local businesses including restaurants, a brewery, artisan shops and the Montgomery Museum.



Roanoke Street Corridor

Along the Roanoke Street Corridor, you'll find one of our rarest treasures - the Starlite Drive-In, one of only a few remaining drive-in movie theatres in Virginia. Coincidentally the outdoor movie experience is located next to Dude's Drive-In restaurant, making the area a one-stop-shop for the nostalgia of drive-ins. Along Roanoke Street you will also find both local and corporate coffee stops as well as a variety of options for your automotive needs. This area is easily accessible to citizens and those traveling on Interstate 81.



Uptown

There's a reason Christiansburg is considered the retail hub of the New River Valley. Travel along North Franklin Street and you'll find national brands to fit any of your needs. Take the family out for a game of bowling, or make it a date night with dinner and a movie.



Located behind Christiansburg Middle School, Harkrader has three lighted, multi-purpose fields, a press box, concessions area and restrooms. Enjoy the walking path, two basketball courts, picnic table and two playground areas.
