Eight Mile Bridge Challenge Walk

- I would like to register for the Christiansburg Parks and Recreation Eight Mile Bridge Challenge on Sept. 21, 2019.
- I realize there will only be room for the first 60 individuals who sign up. The registration deadline is Monday, Sept. 9.
- Any walker under the age of 17 must be supervised by an adult.
- The walk will be held rain or shine. Check in on Sept. 21 begins at 8 a.m. at the Christiansburg Recreation Center, and all walkers must be on site by 8:15 a.m.

In consideration of the privilege to participate in the Eight Mile Bridge Challenge Walk event, I hereby freely agree to and make the following contractual representations and agreements: I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT BY SIGNING THIS DOCUMENT, I AM ASSUMING RISKS, AND AGREEING TO INDEMNIFY, NOT TO SUE AND RELEASE FROM LIABILITY THE TOWN OF CHRISTIANSBURG AND ITS OFFICERS, PARKS AND RECREATION DIRECTOR, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS, INSURERS, VOLUNTEERS, AND SPONSORS (COLLECTIVELY "RELEASEES"), AND THAT I AM GIVING UP SUBSTANTIAL LEGAL RIGHTS. THIS RELEASE IS A CONTRACT WITH LEGAL AND BINDING CONSEQUENCES AND IT APPLIES TO ALL ACTIVITIES AT THE EVENT, REGARDLESS WHETHER OR NOT LISTED ABOVE. I HAVE READ IT CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING, AND I UNDERSTAND WHAT IT MEANS AND WHAT I AM AGREEING TO BY SIGNING. I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT PHYSICAL ACTIVITY MAY BE DANGEROUS AND ASSUME ALL RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH PARTICIPATING IN THIS EVENT. For myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, assignees, and successors in interest (collectively "Successors") I HEREBY WAIVE, RELEASE, DISCHARGE, HOLD HARMLESS, AND PROMISE TO INDEMNIFY AND NOT SUE the Releasees, which also shall include all organizers and promoting organizations, property owners, law enforcement agencies, public entities, and property owners that are in any manner connected with this event, and their respective agents, officials, and employees, FROM ANY AND ALL RIGHTS AND CLAIMS INCLUDING CLAIMS ARISING FROM THE RELEASEES' OWN NEGLIGENCE TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, which I have or which may hereafter accrue to me and from any and all damages which may be sustained by me directly or indirectly in connection with, or arising out of, my participation in or association with the event, or travel to or return from the event. I agree it is my sole responsibility to be familiar with the event course, the Releasees' rules, and all traffic and pedestrian laws and agree to comply with all such rules, laws, and regulations. Furthermore, I also agree that I have appropriate health care coverage for this activity.

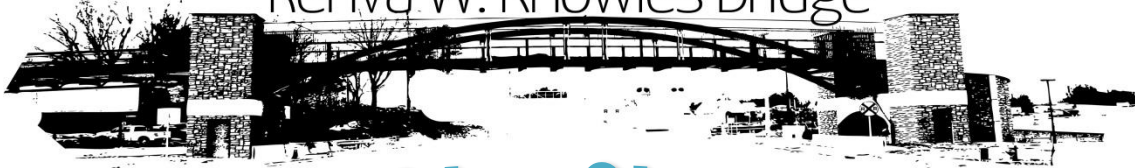

Entry Fee: FREE

- Registration deadline is Monday, Sept. 9.

Schedule: Check in begins at 8 a.m. on Sept. 21 at the Christiansburg Recreation Center, and participants must be on site by 8:15. The shuttle bus will depart for the Blacksburg Library at 8:30 a.m. FOR SAFETY REASONS, NO ANIMALS ARE PERMITTED ON THE SHUTTLE BUSES!

Course: The walk on the Huckleberry Trail will begin at the Blacksburg Library and end at the Christiansburg Recreation Center. Course description available at www.christiansburg.org/recreation.

Approximate Walk Time and Length: 2.5 - 3 hours; approximately 8.3 miles

Age Groups: 17 & under must be accompanied by an adult.

Hydration: Proper hydration will be the responsibility of the participant. Please bring your own water in your own personal water bottle. Water stations will be located at the Warm Hearth road crossing and Renva W. Knowles Bridge.

Post-walk: Free beverages will be available for walkers at the completion of the walk at event headquarters.

Restrooms: Available at event headquarters (no showers).
