The undersigned agrees to the following terms and conditions:

1. Conduct all land disturbing activities in accordance with Chapter 16, Code of the Town Christiansburg (Erosion and Sediment Control and Stormwater Management Ordinance) and the latest edition of the Virginia Erosion and Sediment Control Handbook.
2. The Town Engineering Department will be notified in writing of intent to begin land disturbance to install initial perimeter controls at least 72 hours prior to the commencement of land disturbance.
3. Maintain a signed Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) and adhere to all other permit requirements, including the requirements to promptly notify, in no case less than 24 hours, the local VSMP Authority and DEQ of unusual and extraordinary discharges, including flooding or other acts of nature; and requirements to report any noncompliance which may adversely affect surface waters or may endanger public health within 24 hours.
4. Acknowledge that approval for coverage under this agreement does not relieve any operator of the responsibility to comply with any other applicable federal, state or local statute, ordinance or regulation.
5. Install all perimeter erosion and sediment controls prior to land disturbing activities. At a minimum, such controls shall include silt fencing, construction entrance, sediment traps, sediment basins, etc. required as shown on the approved plan.
6. If so directed by the signed preconstruction meeting notes, contact the Town of Christiansburg for inspection and approval of all perimeter field controls and approval of same prior to commencing subsequent land disturbing activities.
7. Install additional erosion and sediment controls during construction as necessary and as required by the Town E&S inspector.
8. Right-of-entry is granted to the Town of Christiansburg personnel for the purpose of inspecting and monitoring for compliance with Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance.
9. Prevent the transport of mud, dirt, and debris onto public rights-of-way and clean pavement immediately when transport occurs.
10. Take all steps necessary to prevent damage to other persons or properties. The Town of Christiansburg accepts no liability for such damage.
11. The Town Building Official will not conduct footing inspections until the Site Plan and Land Disturbing Permit has been approved.
12. The Operator listed shall be in charge of and responsible for the land disturbing activities permitted under the Construction General Permit Conditions for this project regardless of any authorization for another person to sign SWPPP related documents, including inspections and records of grading activities. The property Owner bears ultimate responsibility for conformance with Erosion and Sediment Control Law and regulations.
13. Failure to comply with the above provisions will result in the issuance of a Noncompliance Notice. Failure to comply within the time specified will result in revocation of the Land Disturbance Permit, forfeiture of a portion or all of the bond amount, and/or penalties as provided by the Town of Christiansburg Erosion and Sediment Control and Stormwater Management Ordinance.
