Daria Eirich is the Town's new Neighborhood Services Coordinator. Daria is the person you can call about tall grass, trash, or structural building problems within the Town. You might also call Daria if you are in need of local assistance in regards to certain health and housing issues. If you see a concern (ie. a broken down porch, inoperable vehicles on private property, or certain internal issues on your rental unit) call or submit a request online for assistance. The Town will walk you through the process so you know exactly what to expect. If you are an owner or property manager with work to be done, feel free to reach out and we will do our best to connect you with needed resources.

The Neighborhood Services department assists in maintaining properties, property values, and above all, ensuring the safety and wellbeing of Christiansburg Citizens within their homes. Neighborhood Services has a policy of education and assistance. It is our goal to work with each citizen to keep the Town beautiful and keep each other safe.
