RECYCLE THIN, SINGLE-USE PLASTICS



FOR A
COMMUNITY
BENCH!

The Christiansburg Farmers Market is now one of two event locations that you can recycle plastic grocery bags for the good of the community.

The Parks and Recreation Department will now be accepting donations of single-use, thin plastics at its Rockin' Main Concert Series events. Those plastics eventually turn to public-use benches!

Grocery bags aren't the only thing you can recycle. You can also give produce bags and bread bags, cereal box liners and ice bags, as well as resealable bags, and case wraps from bulk items like bottled water.

You can also recycle newspaper sleeves, dry cleaning bags, plastic shopping bags and bubble wrap! If the community can collect more than 500 pounds of plastic refuse in a six-month span (about 40,500 plastic bags), eco-friendly company Trex will donate a high-performance composite bench to Christiansburg!

As always, you can also drop off your recyclable single-use, thin plastics to the Christiansburg Recreation Department during business hours.

FALL CLEANUP: OCTOBER 1-14



In April and October each year, the Town offers free special collection periods for residents to place out larger items for pickup. To make it easier on collection crews, please place cleanup items within 10 feet of the street pavement and separate them from your regular trash. Please do not block ditches, gutters, sidewalks, water meters or sewer cleanouts. The Town is not responsible for any items left at or near the street that residents did not intend to have collected. Piles that do not comply with cleanup rules will not be collected. Please also separate materials by type (i.e. pile bagged leaves, tree limbs and trimmings separately). Loose leaf collection will run from November 7 to December 30. Loose materials must be placed in bags/containers not exceeding 32 gallons. Leaves must be bagged. For a full list of accepted items, please visit www.christiansburg.org/cleanupFAQ. Though special collection trucks follow regular garbage routes, cleanup may run a day or two behind trash collection schedules, depending on volume. If it is nearing the end of the cleanup cycle and your items have not been collected, please call 540-382-1151. Throughout the year, residents may also set out their brush for complimentary monthly collection. Please visit www.christiansburg.org/brush to learn more. Brush collection will not run in October as it is part of Fall Cleanup.
