




TOWN COUNCIL APPROVES FY 2025-2026 BUDGET

BUDGET REVENUES: \$92,724,285



BUDGET EXPENDITURES: \$122,719,004



On June 10, Town Council adopted the fiscal year 2025–26 budget, which includes a water rate increase. The new rates will appear on bills sent on or around August 1 for July usage. For customers within Town limits, the rate is \$11 for the first 1,000 gallons, \$13 per 1,000 gallons up to 49,999, and \$10 per 1,000 gallons for usage of 50,000 gallons or more. Rates outside Town limits will be 200% of the in-town rates. Sewer, garbage, recycling, and property tax rates remain unchanged.
