## FALL CLEANUP: OCTOBER 6-17



Each April and October, the Town provides residents with a free special collection period for large-item pickup. To help our crews work efficiently, please place all cleanup materials within 10 feet of the street pavement and keep them separate from your household trash. Be sure not to block sidewalks, ditches, gutters, water meters, or sewer cleanouts.

### Please remember:

- The Town is not responsible for items left near the street that you did not intend to have collected.
- Piles that do not follow cleanup guidelines will not be picked up.
- Separate materials by type (for example, bagged leaves in one pile, and tree limbs or trimmings in another).
