WINTER WEATHER TIPS

Snow could be in our forecast, so before the flurries start flying, here are some tips to help you prepare and minimize accidents:

When Public work trucks are prepping the streets or removing snow, please do not swerve around the trucks and plows.

Snow plowing will deposit snow along street shoulders, curbs and driveway openings. Because of this, it is recommended that residents shovel driveways **after** their street is plowed.

Property owners, both residents and businesses, are responsible for keeping the sidewalks in front of their property safe for travel after the snow stops falling. If you have a sidewalk in front of your home/business, please keep it clear of snow and ice. Town Code requires it be cleared within 24 hours of your street being plowed.

When facing the street, shovel snow to the right or into your yard to minimize the amount that may get plowed back into your driveway.

If inclement weather is expected, please avoid parking on the street. Parking on the street prevents snow plows from fully and safely clearing the street and may result in vehicle damage.
