Blacksburg Transit plans to add new routes in Christiansburg



Increased bus services are planned for Roanoke Street and Radford Street as a one-year pilot project.

A recent study of current ridership in Christiansburg identified areas with an unmet demand for public transportation. In response, Blacksburg Transit (BT) and the Town of Christiansburg are recommending the addition of 17 new bus stops in Christiansburg.

While most of the new stops will be along Roanoke Street and Radford Street, BT also plans to increase how frequently buses stop at other stops.

For stops currently serviced every 120 minutes, BT plans to start servicing the stops every hour. This change will help improve access to popular destinations such as the Kenneth B. Gibson Memorial Park and Ride, the Montgomery County Courthouse, the Christiansburg library, and a number of apartment complexes.

Bus stops that are already serviced every 60 minutes - including the Christiansburg Aquatic Center and New River Valley Mall - will not be affected.

Snow, ice and water line breaks--oh my!

Winter is coming, and it never hurts to brush up on our winter weather tips before the first snow of the season. We also want to share the steps we take during winter weather events to help keep residents and visitors safe.

In anticipation of icy road conditions, Public Works crews will salt roads. Crews will also de-ice roads and plow snow. Primary roads (main thoroughfares with a high traffic volume) are always cleared first to ensure that snow removal crews and emergency vehicles are able to access all areas in town. There are 53 primary roads in the Town of Christiansburg.

Non-primary roads are considered secondary roads. During winter weather, secondary roads are treated and cleared in alternating order so the same streets are not always addressed last. There are 392 secondary roads in the Town of Christiansburg. Because of the large number of streets requiring attention, Public Works crews cannot respond to special requests to clear roads for medical, work or other reasons.

During the winter, you may notice an increase in the number of water line breaks around town. This is perfectly normal. As the seasons change, temperatures fluctuate, causing the ground to shift. This means water lines can shift as well, which sometimes leads to a break. To report a water line break during normal business hours, please call the

Public Works Department at (540) 382-1151. If you need to report a break after business hours, please call the Police Department's nonemergency line at (540) 382-4343.

Please keep the following winter weather tips in mind:

- If you have a sidewalk in front of your home or business, please keep it clear of snow and ice. Town Code requires that it be cleared within 24 hours of your street being plowed.
- Snow plowing will deposit snow along street shoulders, curbs and driveway openings. Because of this, it is recommended that residents shovel driveways after their street is plowed.
- When facing the street, shovel snow to the right or into your yard to minimize the amount that may get plowed back into your driveway.
- If inclement weather is expected, please avoid parking on the street. Parking on the street prevents snow plows from fully and safely clearing the street and may result in vehicle damage.

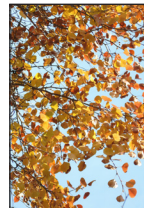
